WCATC 2022 Pull Rules

General Rules

- 1. All drivers must be 16 years of age or older & must sign release form.
 - a. Children between the ages of 14-16 may pull with approval of track officials
 - b. Drivers may be require to provide proof of age
 - c. Drivers under the age of 18 must have a parent/guardian signature
- 2. Hook fee is \$15 per hook
- 3. A tractor may pull twice in the same class if there are 2 different drivers
- 4. All drivers must remain seated during the pull
- 5. Maximum drawbar height is 18" from the level ground to the top of the hitch
 - a. Minimum drawbar length is 18" from the center of the rear axle to the hitch point
 - b. Tractors must have a pulling loop or clevis
 - c. All hitches must be approved at the time of weigh in by the scale operator
- 6. Track length is 200ft with a floating finish
 - a. A pull off will occur if 2 or more competitors pull over 300ft in the same class
- 7. Anything falling off of the tractor while it is on the track will result in a disqualification
- 8. If a driver stops the tractor within the first 50ft , they may have one additional attempt to pull, except in a pull off situation
- 9. Front end lift is limited to 24inches from the ground to the bottom of the front tractor tire
- 10. Any part of the tractor or sled touching the boundary lines during the pull will result in a disqualification
- 11. Weights cannot extend past the rear tires in a rearward direction
- 12.A driver may protest another driver's tractor if they are in the same class
 - The protester's tractor will also be inspected
- 13. Officials have the right to enforce the rules at all times.
 - a. Officials have the right deem a tractor to unsafe
 - b. Decisions made by track officials are final
- 14. WCATC reserves the right to add or change classes as needed
- decisions may not perfect and we may make a mistake, but unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Those who violate this rule will be asked to leave without a refund.

Antique/Show/Field Stock Classes 1965 and older 3000, 3500, 4500, 5500, 6500, 7500, 8500

- 1. Tractor must be factory appearing
 - a. All original sheet metal must in place
 - b. Must have factory drawbar and hitch
 - c. Must have factory style seat base and seat
 - d. Factory hydraulics, pto, pulleys etc... must be in place if so equipped
 - e. Factory air intakes must be in place
 - f. Must have completely factory powertrain
 - i. If the engine has been replaced it must be the same model engine
- 2. Tractors must run on gasoline, diesel, propane or kerosene
- 3. Solid, pneumatic, radials and steel wheels allowed. No cut tires permitted.
- 4. Rpm's and horsepower must not exceed factory specifications by 10% RVESTER
- 5. Factory weights only and must be fastened in a factory manor
 - a. All thread is permitted but homemade and aftermarket wheel weight brackets are
- 6. Tire sizes are limited to 1 size over stock according to tractordata.com and using the modern tire size conversion chart washington conversion.
- 7. Tractors will be allowed 100lbs over the class weight
- 8. Officials have to right to decide if a tractor is truly an antique class tractor
- 9. 3 mph speed limit
 - a. Only 1 horn warning will be given. The driver must slow down immediately
 - b. If the horn blows a 2nd time or the driver does not slow immediately they will be disqualified

4.0 Open/Mild Class 1965 and older 3500, 4500, 5500, 6500, 7500, 8500, 9500

- 1. All engines must be of the same make, number of cylinders and mounted as the original
- 2. All tractors must run on gasoline, propane or diesel
- 3. All engines must be naturally aspirated, except a factory turbocharged AC D19
- 4. Non diesel engines may only have a single updraft carburetor
- 5. Field/Un Cut Tires Only
 - a. 3,000lb-4500lb Tire size limits
 - i. 18.4 on a 26" rim or smaller
 - ii. 16.9 on a 34" rim or smaller
 - iii. 15.5 on a 38" rim or smaller
 - b. 5,500lb-9,500lb Tire size limits
 - i. 23.1 on a 26" rim or smaller
 - ii. 20.8 on a 34" rim or smaller
 - iii. 18.4 on a 38" rim or smaller
- 6. Tractors will be allowed 100lbs over the weight class
- 7. 3.5mph speed limit
 - a. Only 1 horn warning will be given. The driver must slow down immediately
 - b. If the horn blows a 2nd time **or** the driver does not slow down immediately, they will be disqualified
- 8. 4 & 6 cylinder engines are limited to 3,000 rpms. 2 cylinders are limited to 1,500 rpm
- 9. Aftermarket/suitcase weights and brackets are allowed but must be secured
- 10. Adjustable hitches are permitted





5mph Hot Class 1965 and older 3,500lb, 4,500lb, 5,500lb, 6,500lb, 7,500lb

- 1. All engines must be of the same make, number of cylinders and mounted as the original
- 2. All tractors must run on gasoline, propane or diesel
- 3. All engines must be naturally aspirated, except a factory turbocharged AC D19
- 4. Non diesel engines may only have a single updraft carburetor
- 5. Top Cut Tires Permitted
 - a. 3,000lb-4500lb Tire size limits
 - i. 18.4 on a 26" rim or smaller
 - ii. 16.9 on a 34" rim or smaller
 - iii. 15.5 on a 38" rim or smaller
 - b. 5,500lb-9,500lb Tire size limits
 - i. 23.1 on a 26" rim or smaller
 - ii. 20.8 on a 34" rim or smaller
 - iii. 18.4 on a 38" rim or smaller
- 6. Tractors will be allowed 100lbs over the weight class
- 7. 5mph speed limit
 - a. Only 1 horn warning will be given. The driver must slow down immediately
 - b. If the horn blows a 2nd time **or** the driver does not slow down immediately, they will be disqualified
- 8. No Rpm Limit
- 9. Aftermarket/suitcase weights and brackets are allowed but must be secured
- 10. Wheelie Bars Required
- 11. Adjustable hitches are permitted
